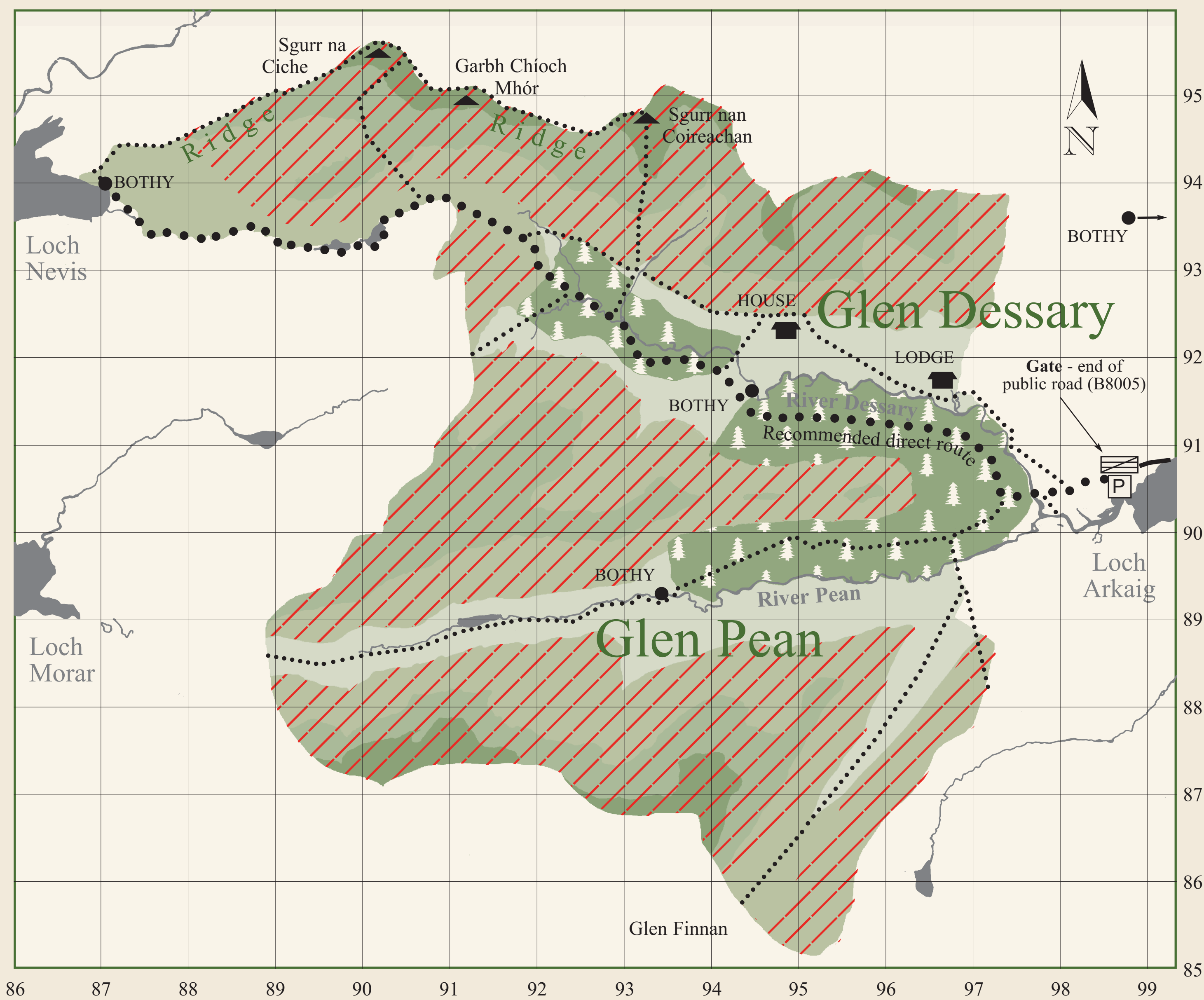


IMPORTANT ACCESS INFORMATION

STALKING

If the removable sign on the gate is displayed, stalking parties are actively working in Glen Dessary and Glen Pean areas on that day. On stalking days please stick to the low lying and ridge routes marked in black on the map below and avoid corrie and hill face areas marked in red.



RED DEER MANAGEMENT / STALKING

Management of the deer population through stalking is essential. The cull maintains the health of the deer stock and prevents environmental damage through over-grazing. Stalking and venison production are the main source of employment and income for this local Highland community. Stalking takes place from the 1st July to 16th February, but the period from the 20th of August to the 20th of October (excluding Sundays) is critical for us and is the most sensitive to disturbance.
